The UGPP Invites Technical and Financial Proposals, **(Single Stage Two Envelope basis) for “preparation of conceptual design, master planning and detailed design for establishment of National Botanical garden’ at Kalma Chowk Bhara Kahu Zoological Survey of Pakistan, Islamabad”.** (Supervision of implantation of above mentioned establishment/development process of National Botanical Garden)

The UGPP seeks the services of well reputed national and international consultancy firm/ consortium of consultants to prepare concept design, master plan, detailed design, PC-I document and business plan for developing this garden as a ‘nature park’ on 725 acres located between the hills of Bani Gala for public recreation and for strengthening the overall green cover in the region. The land for the proposed National Botanical Garden is located between the hills of Bani Gala, about 15 Kms north east of Islamabad at an elevation range of 530 to 700m (above msl) and comprises of a long ridges stretching between Simly Dam Road and Bani Gala. 1. Instructions to the bidders

"Single Stage Two Envelop Procedure" will be adopted for open competitive bidding. Proposals should be submitted in two separate envelopes with the titles as "technical" and "financial" proposals, which should be enclosed in a single envelop with clear heading "Proposal/Bid for **“preparation of conceptual design, master planning and detailed design for establishment of ‘National Botanical Garden’ at Kalma Chowk Bhara Kahu Zoological Survey of Pakistan, Islamabad.(Supervision of above mentioned establishment/development process of National Botanical Garden)** Technical & financial bid shall be submitted on prescribed format. The Financial proposals should accompany a bid security equivalent to Five percent (5%) of the bid amount in the form of Pay Order / Demand Draft in favour of “National Programme Director, Up – Scaling of Green Pakistan Programme”. Financial proposal shall be valid for 60 days.

1.1 Sealing of Bid:

The proposals should be prepared in accordance with tender documents and sealed properly and envelopes should be clearly marked as "Technical Proposal" or "Financial Proposal" in legible letters with the tender heading and its closing and opening date and time. If the envelopes are not sealed and marked properly, UGPP will assume no responsibility for the bid's misplacement.

1.2 Submission of Bid:

The bid should be submitted as per given closing date and time advertised in the tender notice. The late bid will not be entertained. No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadlines for submission of bids and the expiration of the period of bid validity specified in the bid document. Withdrawal of a bid during this interval may result in the bidder's forfeiture of its bid security (earnest money).

1.3 Opening of Bid:

The proposals shall be opened publicly on specified date & time in the presence of tender opening and evaluation committee of UGPP and Bidder's representatives who are present shall be given the attendance sheet evidencing of their presence. In case of holiday is announced by the Govt. of Pakistan or "Force Majeure Situation", the tenders will be opened on next working day or as shall be intimated by the UGPP.

The bidder's names, quoted rates, bid security attached and such other details considered appropriate will be announced at the time of opening of bids. No bid shall be rejected at the time of opening of bids, except for the late bids, which shall be returned unopened to the Bidder. During evaluation of the bids, UGPP may, at its discretion, ask the Bidder for a clarification of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, and no change in the

prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted. If a bid is not substantially responsive to the terms & conditions/particulars of the tender documents, it will be rejected by UGPP and may not subsequently be made responsive by the bidder by correction of the nonconformity. A bid once opened in accordance with the prescribed procedure shall be subject to only those rules, regulation and policies that are in force at the time of issue of notice for invitation for bids.

2. Consultant / Firm's Scope of Work and Responsibilities

The proposed establishment of National Botanical Garden is aimed at creating a Nature Park facility that fulfils the primary objectives of conservation, recreation, education, public awareness as well as research. The long term aims and objectives of establishing the National Botanical Garden' as part of the nature park are:

Vision:

To inspire people to conserve and cherish biodiversity and botanical heritage of Pakistan for a sustainable future.

Mission:

Discover, cultivate, showcase and protect Pakistan's unique plant diversity through innovative display, engaging communication and inspiring people to conserve natural resources.

Objective:

- i. The overarching objective of the project is to develop a 'nature park' to collect, display, conserve the wide variety of flora from across Pakistan.
- ii. To develop a 'botanical enclave' that brings together themes aligned to different regional flora from towering mountains to hilly areas, dry plateaus, to salt range, Suleiman and Khirthar range, riverine to coastal belt to desert areas. From trees, shrubs, bushes, grasses and every type of botanical species to provide a holistic display of botanical richness and variety in the country.
- iii. To create an enclave that can provide a real-time information to the public local and international about the rich flora in the country.
- iv. Create a digital platform of information for facilitating communication relating to the botanical landscape in the country and to encourage ownership protection and conservation.
- v. Develop the facility as an ecotourism resort.

The Consultant / Firm having international experience of developing National Biodiversity Parks is asked to perform the following services in line with international best practices:

2.1. Conceptual Design and Master Planning

A. Survey and Investigation

The Consultant / Firm will be required to carry out the following through recognized experts/professionals in the field:

a. Demarcation

Demarcation and coordinates determination of the identified site and a general survey of the immediate surroundings will be carried out.

b. Documentation / Mapping of Existing Facilities

The consultant / firm will carry out a detailed survey of the existing facilities; proper document / mapping of the existing facilities and, wherever required, supplement his work with pictures / videos to establish a baseline. The consultant / firm will use digital camera, digital video and other latest technology to carry out this part of assignment. The consultant shall also provide satellite imagery duly marked with boundary lines and existing and proposed features.

c. Reconnaissance Survey

The Consultant / Firm will carry out reconnaissance survey of the identified land parcel so as to collect all relevant data for use in the Planning and Design of proposed works including, soil data, geo-technical data, meteorological data, hydrological data, Biodiversity Baseline data and Environmental impact Assessment (EIA) data etc. for incorporation into the master plan.

d. Detailed Topographic Survey and Soil Investigations

Before detailed designing, the Consultant / Firm shall carry out detailed topographic survey, sub-soil investigations and laboratory analysis of the soil samples from approved laboratories to assess the ground conditions and its suitability for both plantation and construction works. Geotechnical investigation of the site shall also be carried out to obtain information about engineering characteristics of sub-soil and to establish appropriate foundation design parameters for the proposed structures.

B. Concept Development and Master Planning

The Consultants / Firm will carry out the concept development and prepare the Master Plan of a world-class Botanical Garden as part of a nature park. Master Plan should cover at least the following features:

- a) Review / discussion of the best models of Botanical Gardens that are part of nature parks functioning in developed and developing countries keeping in view the existing features / infrastructure.
- b) Study of history of land under consideration, statistics and overview of existing facilities.
- c) Review of Islamabad Master Plan and its integration with the plan being prepared for establishing the Botanical Garden.
- d) Identification of basic and specific international standards for Botanical Gardens.

- e) Code of conduct for group visitors for the garden.
- f) Operational guidelines including:
 - Zoning policy and guidelines
 - Land use policy and guidelines
 - Plan for horticulture, floriculture, wilderness, forestation, wildlife, soft and hard intervention, etc.
 - Infrastructure policies and guidelines
 - Transport policy and guidelines covering inside and outside transport
 - Marketing & Tourism policy and guidelines
 - Community and social policy and guidelines e.g. ethics, cleanliness, etc
- g) Propose flora and fauna that can be planted / introduced.
- h) Administrative arrangement for operating the garden and the nature in general
- i) Including institutional setup, organogram and job descriptions of key staff k. Institutional arrangements on sustainability of interventions

Under this item of work, the consultant / firm will be required to:

- i. Prepare and submit innovative conceptual integrated Master Plan of a world-class Botanical Garden as part of a nature park, Landscape/Architectural Design and Outline Proposal for the proposed garden as part of the nature park for approval by the Client.
- ii. Finalize the preliminary conceptual design and master plan incorporating the Client's suggestions and comments.
- iii. Prepare and submit by laws, drawings to local approving agencies (if required).
- iv. Prepare animated computer model of the garden and the nature park in general / 3-D visual walkthrough of the park and its facilities.

- iii. Exploration of possible models for out sourcing the operation of the garden and the park in particular through Public Private Partnership.
- iv. Strategic recommendation for HR management required to maintain the garden and the park in professional management mode.
- v. Develop a realistic model for the size of the visitor market segments and their respective spending power which will translate into admission pricing and discounting types and price ranges of F&B and retail.
- vi. Estimate source of revenue: admission charges, F & B, rides, photography, retail, donations, government subsidies etc.
- vii. Estimate the capital as well as operating costs of the project.
- viii. Develop a 10 year profit and loss projection for the project.

 - f. The offer is made by unauthorized agent of firm/company.

 - h. The offer is conditional.
2. Prices quoted by the firm /company should be inclusive of all applicable taxes/duties and delivery charges in Pak Rupee. All admissible taxes impose by the GOP from time to time shall be catered for in the quoted rates.
3. The bid must accompany **5%** of total bid price in shape of DD/Pay Order in the name of National Project Director, Up-Scaling Green Pakistan Programme (UGPP), Islamabad on account of earnest money (refundable).
4. The bids will be evaluated in line with evaluation of this document and firm/company found to be substantially responsive and qualified to the evaluation criteria will for opening of financial bid.
